GENERAL FORMATION

- Providing ideas, insight, and logistical support under the direction of the CFM leadership for Men and Women's Formation events, including summer studies and quarterly gatherings

COMMUNITY

- Supporting the connections process by occasionally facilitating and supporting logistics for New Leader Trainings, Community Connect classes, and Gospel Community Leader events
- Occasionally develop resources and guides to help leaders foster rich conversation in our small groups, called Gospel Communities
- Invest in the care and shepherding of individuals and leaders in our church through connections and meetings with church visitors, members, leaders
