## MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES

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### LEADERSHIP & DISCIPLESHP

- Prepare for and help lead weekly gatherings, including teaching, small groups, and overall environment.
- Collaborate with the Director of Park Students to develop vision and direction for the student worship team.
- Support the Director of Park Students and the Park Students Coordinator with planning, coordinating, and executing ministry events.
- Prepare for and help lead seasonal events such as retreats, camps, and mission trips.

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### MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENT LEADERSHIP

- Provide oversight and coordination for discipleship initiatives targeting middle school girls (grades 6–8).
- Build intentional relationships with middle school girl volunteers, offering care, discipleship, and support.

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### TRAINING & MEETINGS

- Participate in weekly Park Students team meetings.
- Attend Family Ministry events and gatherings as assigned.
- Monthly 1:1 with the Director of Park Students for mentorship, feedback, and growth.
